WM10 (10 Watt Wallmount) Supplies Power in an Uncommonly Trim Package

This series is targeted for commercial applications of OEMs deploying their products in the United States.

- An uncommonly trim, compact design (the face is only 29mm wide)
- Space saving orientation which occupies only one outlet (not two) on the wall or power strip
- High quality FR4 board (no paper board, unlike ordinary low power wallmounts)
- 5 year warranty

The series includes three new models, reflecting a high efficiency design. These products accept 100-120 VAC, and provide fully regulated output of 10 Watts DC power at 5, 12 or 24 Volts. All models in the series meet the EMI requirements of CISPR 22 Class B and FCC Class B, and are UL/cUL listed.
